**MIT Think Scholars Program- Deadline January 1, 2024.** The MIT THINK Scholars Program is an educational outreach initiative offered by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology that promotes high school student-led innovation in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. THINK accepts research project proposals from high school students across the US, providing mentorship and funding to a select few to make their ideas a reality.

**Diller Teen Tikkun Olam Awards- Deadline January 5, 2024.** Eligibility requirements Applicants and nominees must be: 13-19 years old (on January 5, 2024), Identify as Jewish, A resident of the United States, Volunteering without any compensation, currently serving in a leadership role on a project or initiative that embodies the values of *tikkun olam* — repairing the world <https://dillerteenawards.org/apply/>

**GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship – Deadline: January 5, 2024** – \$10,000 annually up to four years. for high school seniors nationwide who showcase leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship. Minimum 3.0 GPA. **AWAF Scholarship – Due January 8, 2024** – Females who have a passion for a career or advancement in the automotive, mobility, and its related industries. Must be accepted to a collegiate program and have a 3.0 GPA. <https://awafoundation.org/Scholarships>

**APIA Scholarship Program – Due January 9, 2024** – Must have ancestry/heritage/ethnicity from Asia and/or the Pacific Islands. GPA of 2.7 or higher. Must file the FAFSA by April. [APIA Scholarship - APIA Scholars : APIA Scholars](#)

**Jackie Robinson Foundation Scholarship – Due January 10, 2024** – Must be a graduating minority high school student. Present evidence of financial need. Four essays are required. [Apply - Jackie Robinson Foundation](#)

**Fidelity Scholars Program- Deadline January 11, 2024. Eligibility Requirements:** 2.5 – 3.5 unweighted GPA or GED Pell eligible and/or demonstrate financial need Attend as an incoming 2024-25 freshman at a 4-year accredited college or university in the state that you reside Student applicants must come from underrepresented populations and historically underserved communities who have faced systemic barriers and challenges to economic mobility. We specifically encourage students from Black, Latino, Native American (with documented tribal affiliation) and underrepresented Asian American/Pacific Islander heritage to apply. <https://uncf.org/programs/fidelity-scholars-program>

**Mensa Foundation – Due January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024** – Essay of 550 words. Must be enrolled in a degree program at an accredited U.S. institution of higher learning during the following academic year following the application date. **National Washington Crossing Foundation Scholarship- Deadline January 15, 2024.** Are you a graduating high school senior pursuing a career in government service? If so, consider applying for the National Washington Crossing Foundation Scholarship! **StudentCam Scholarship- Deadline January 19, 2024.** Are you an aspiring filmmaker? If so, consider applying for the StudentCam scholarship! **Diversity Advancement Scholarship- Deadline January 19, 2024.** Are you a high school senior or college student planning to major in architecture? If so, you might be interested in applying for the Diversity Advancement Scholarship! **U.S. Junior Chamber International Scholarship Program- Deadline January 19, 2024.** Each year, the U.S. Junior Chamber International (JCI) Senate Foundation grants \$1,500 scholarships to graduating high school seniors who plan to continue their education at accredited post-secondary colleges, universities or vocational schools. 3.75 GPA or higher will be considered. Application will have to be downloaded and items listed on the checklist mailed back to the state representative. **Tuskegee Airmen Scholarship- Deadline January 24, 2024.** Applicants must be students from accredited high schools who will graduate (or who have graduated) in the spring of their

academic cycle. Additionally, those who apply must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least three point zero (3.0) on a four-point scale. If you're a high school senior with plans to pursue a career in aviation or aerospace, we encourage you to apply!

**Technology Addiction Awareness Scholarship- Deadline January 30, 2024.** Are you a U.S. citizen or legal resident currently in high school, college, graduate school, or homeschool? Further, do you believe that too much screen time and technology addictions are having a negative impact on young people today? If so, Digital Responsibility wants to hear about it! **Daughters of the American Revolution Scholarships- Deadline January 31, 2024.** Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin or disability. Essay, transcript, recommendations, one page resume, and proof of citizenship will all be required. **Union Plus Scholarship- Deadline January 31, 2024-** Current and retired members of unions participating in any Union Plus program, their spouses and their dependent children (as defined by IRS regulations) are eligible. Members of participating unions from the U.S., Puerto Rico, Guam and the U.S. Virgin Islands and Canada are eligible. The applicant must be accepted into a U.S. accredited college, university, community college, technical or trade school at the time the award is issued. Awards must be used for the 2024 - 2025 school year.

**Baer Reintegration Scholarship- Deadline January 31, 2024-** The goal of the Baer Reintegration Scholarship is to help people with schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder or bipolar disorder acquire the educational and vocational skills necessary to reintegrate into society, secure jobs, and regain their lives. Essay required, 3 letters of recommendation (1 from prescribing authority of mental illness, and two general letters of recommendation.)

**Henry David Thoreau Scholarship- Deadline February 1, 2024-** Demonstrate strong academic qualifications and a commitment to an environmental field.

**Association of Women in Mathematics Essay Contest- Deadline February 1, 2024-** Contest is open to students in grades 6 through 12 and undergraduate students. Student must submit an essay based on an interview with a woman currently working in a mathematical career. <https://awm-math.org/awards/student-essay-contest/>

**1 for 2 Scholarship- Deadline: February 1, 2024** - Complete the application, including three short essays on your goals and values, leadership experience, and overcoming difficulties. Eligibility: Must be living in the U.S. and attending or planning to attend a U.S. college with at least a 3.7 GPA. Amount: Up to \$25,000 <https://www.1for2edu.com/scholarship/>

**Harriet Fitzgerald Scholarship- Deadline: February 1, 2024-** Scholarship is open to female graduating high school seniors who wish to attend a women's college in the United States. Applicants must have a GPA of 3.7 or higher. **Amount:** \$10,000 <https://thesunflowerinitiative.org/apply/>

**AMS Freshman Undergraduate Scholarships- Deadline: February 3, 2024-** Open to students entering their freshman year of college in the fall of 2024 and must be planning to pursue a degree in the atmospheric or related oceanic or hydrologic sciences. **Elks Legacy Awards- Deadline February 5, 2024-** For the 2024 contest, any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild, or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2021, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2021, is eligible to apply. **The National Ag Day Essay Contest- Deadline: February 9, 2024-** Open to high school students who submit an original essay of 450 words or less, or a two-minute video, on the following topic: *"Agriculture in the Future: If I had Two Minutes to Talk to a Farmer."* **Amount:** \$1000 <https://www.agday.org/essay-contest>

**Red Pine Scholars Program- Deadline February 15, 2024-** US Citizen, Permanent resident of Massachusetts, family adjusted gross income less than \$110,000. HS senior. Must enroll as a full-time freshman at a 4-year college. <https://tpi.org/scholarships-college-success/>

**Davidson Fellows Scholarship- Deadline: February 15, 2024-** Open to young people, 18 and under, who have completed a significant piece of work. Application categories are Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Literature, Music, Philosophy and Outside the Box. **Amount:** Up to \$50,000 <https://www.davidsongifted.org/gifted-programs/fellows-scholarship/eligibility/how-to-apply/>

**Hispanic Scholarship Fund- Deadline: February 15, 2024-** Open to students of Hispanic descent who are graduating high school seniors, community colleges students, transfer students,

college students, or graduate students. All majors and graduate fields are accepted, with an emphasis on STEM majors. **Amount:** Up to \$5,000 <https://www.hsf.net/scholarship>

**The Christophers High School Poster Contest- Deadline: February 16, 2024** - Create a poster interpreting the theme "*You Can Make a Difference*" Posters can be drawn, painted, handmade, or created digitally. Eligibility: Must be a U.S. high school student. Amount: Eight awards ranging from \$100 to \$1,000 <https://www.christophers.org/highschoolpostercontest>

**Lounge Lizard Web Design Award- Deadline: February 18, 2024**- Open to all students at an accredited school within the United States or be accepted to begin school at an accredited school within 6 months of application who can submit a design or live URL. The web design can be from past or present. **Amount:** \$1,000 <https://www.loungelizard.com/scholarship/>

**SPJ School Essay Contest- Deadline: February 19, 2024**- Open to students enrolled in grades 9-12 within the United States who will submit an essay on the topic, "*Media literacy is connected to democracy. What are some top strategies to engage people of all ages with media literacy and democracy?*" **Amount:** Up to \$1,000 <https://jea.org/wp/home/awards-honors/high-school-essay-contest/>

**Vegetarian Resource Group Scholarship- Deadline: February 20, 2024**- Complete the application and write an essay detailing your successes and challenges with vegetarianism and how you promote vegetarianism in your community. Eligibility: Must be a college-bound high school senior graduating in spring 2023 and maintain a vegetarian diet and lifestyle. Amount: One \$10,000 award and two \$5,000 awards <http://www.vrg.org/student/scholar.htm>

**Gordon A. Rich Scholarship- Deadline: February 20, 2024**- Scholarship money is available to offspring of those working in the financial services industry. Each GAR scholarship is worth up to \$50,000 (approximately \$12,500/year) awarded to hardworking high school students who have a financial need. **Amount:** \$12,500 (renewable) <http://www.gordonrich.org/html/req.html>

**Scholars Helping Collars Scholarship- Deadline: February 26, 2024**- Submit an essay between 500 and 1,000 words detailing your volunteer efforts to help animals in need, describing how that involvement has changed your life or shaped your perception on the importance of animal welfare. Eligibility: Must be a high school senior and U.S. resident. Amount: First prize of \$1,500 with second prize of \$300 and third prize of \$200 <https://www.petplay.com/pages/scholarship>

**Sweet and Simple Scholarship- Deadline: February 28, 2024**- Write a short essay about something you received as a gift and why it meant so much to you. ***\*You will have to create an account with Unigo to apply.*** Eligibility: Must be 14 years of age or older and a legal U.S. resident. **The Dream. US National Scholarship Program- Deadline: February 28, 2024-** Applications are open to undocumented immigrant students with or without DACA or TPS who came to the U.S. before the age of 16 and before Nov. 1, 2018. The National Scholarship Award will cover your tuition and fees at one of our Partner Colleges up to a maximum of \$33,000 for a bachelor's degree. **Amount:** Varies up to \$29,000 <https://www.thedream.us/scholarships/national-scholarship/>

**Cosmetology Scholarships- Deadline: February 29, 2024-** 11 Scholarships are open to new and current students who are currently or will be attending an accredited beauty school. **Amount:** Varies from \$2,500 to \$18,000. <https://beautychangeslives.org/scholarships-opportunities/>
