**TO GUIDANCE COUNSELORS AND APPLICANTS**

The College Club of Springfield was established in 1899 to promote the interest of collegiate education for young women. It has been awarding grants since its inception to public high school graduates from the greater Springfield area. This year the College Club will award scholarships of \$5,000. Scholarship recipients are chosen for their need, scholarship, leadership, integrity, and community service. Eligibility is limited to young women ranking in the upper fifth of their class in public schools who have been accepted at a four year accredited college or university. Family's income cannot exceed \$100,000 and must be verified by submission of FAFSA or W-2 form.

Included is a copy of the application form to be completed along with the submission of all required documentation as listed on the application form.

Applications should be returned or postmarked to committee member no later than March 30, 2024

Qualified candidates will be asked to meet with the Scholarship Committee for a personal interview.
