



## **December & January Scholarships**

**Cards Direct Scholarship- Deadline December 1, 2023.** \$1,500. Design a holiday card with original artwork, photographs, or computer graphics Eligibility: Must be at least 17 years old and already accepted or enrolled in an educational organization. <https://www.cardsdirect.com/scholarship.aspx>

**The Citizens Scholarship Sweepstakes (Monthly, Quarterly, and Grand Prize winners)- Deadline December 1, 2023** (“Monthly Entry Periods”) which corresponds with the start and end dates of each calendar month until the end of the Sweepstakes Period. The Sweepstakes Period is also divided into four (4) Quarterly Entry Periods (“Quarterly Entry Periods”) ELIGIBILITY: HS Seniors planning to enroll at least half-time within 1 year of winning award. If a student or immediate family member works for Citizens bank, then you are NOT eligible. Students may also qualify for DEI Quarterly scholarships. Definition of DEI students are listed on the application form. Once you complete the application, your application will be entered in each month’s drawing, if you are not selected as the winner.

**Visionary Scholarship- Deadline December 1, 2023.** \$1,000-\$2,500. All components of the application must be received completely at the time of submission. Applicant will NOT be notified of a partial and/or incomplete application. All applications for the American College Foundation’s Visionary Scholarship Program will consist of:

- Completed ACF Visionary Scholarship Application
- Student’s most recent unofficial high school transcript
- 500-word essay on “Why College is Important to Me”

**Dell Scholars Program- Deadline December 1, 2023.** \$20,000. Scholarship is open to graduating high school seniors who have participated in an approved college readiness program (such as AVID, GEAR UP, Upward Bound – see full list on website) in grades 11 and 12. Applicant must have earned a minimum GPA of 2.4 and demonstrate financial need.

**Ron Brown Scholarship Program- Deadline December 1, 2023.** 50 college scholarships annually in the amount of \$40,000. Interested applicants are strongly encouraged to apply for the Ron Brown Scholar Program provided you meet the following requirements:

- Must be Black/African American.
- Must excel academically.
- Must exhibit exceptional leadership potential.
- Must participate in community service activities.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Be a US citizen or hold a permanent resident visa card.

**The Hagan Scholarship- Deadline December 1, 2023.** Up to \$7,500 each semester for up to 8 consecutive semesters. Must be a US citizen, 3.5 GPA, demonstrates financial need. **Barbara Lotze Scholarship for Future Physics Teachers- Deadline December 1, 2023.** Up to \$3,000. Do you want to become a high school physics teacher? If so, you should check out the Barbara Lotze Scholarship for Future Physics Teachers! **Your Time to Climb Scholarship- Deadline December 1, 2023.** \$2000. **Zack Zolin Athletic Scholarship- Deadline December 1, 2023.** \$500-\$2000. Are you a student athlete currently in college or your senior year of high school? **Ronald V. Dellums Memorial SMART Scholarship. – Due: December 1, 2023.** Full tuition, \$30,000 Annual stipend, and more. Must have a GPA of 3.0. Must maintain a GPA of 3.0 in college. **Rubincam Youth Writing Competition- Deadline December 15, 2023.** \$250-\$500. Submit a genealogy in a biographical narrative format for one family line, including four generations, beginning with you as the first generation. **G2 Overachievers Student Grant- Deadline December 15, 2023.** \$15,000 - \$100,000. Submit 1,000–2,000 handwritten words explaining how you or the person you're nominating makes a difference in the world and why they deserve to be recognized for these efforts. **Medical Scrubs Collection Scholarships- Deadline December 15, 2023.** \$1,000. Applicants for the Medical Scrubs Collection Scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Citizen of the United States or in possession of an Alien Registration Card
- High school senior or enrolled in an accredited U.S. college or university
- Achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Pursuing a degree in the medical field such as therapy, nursing, medicine, nutrition, laboratory science, dentistry, etc.

**Because College is Expensive Scholarship**- **Deadline December 31, 2023**. \$500. Scholarship is open to high school students, adults looking to head back to school, current college students, and anyone looking to attend college or graduate school within 12 months. **GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship** – **Deadline: January 5, 2024** – \$10,000 annually up to four years. for high school seniors nationwide who showcase leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship. Minimum 3.0 GPA. **Diller Teen Tikkun Olam Awards**- **Deadline January 5, 2024**. \$36,000. 13-19 years old (on January 5, 2024), identify as Jewish, a resident of the United States, volunteering without any compensation, Currently serving in a leadership role on a project or initiative that embodies the values of *tikkun olam* — repairing the world <https://dillerteenawards.org/apply/>

**APIA Scholarship Program**- **Deadline January 9, 2024**. \$2,500- \$20,000. Be able to describe their ethnicity, heritage, or ancestry in relation to the countries, territories, or lands in Asia or the Pacific Islands. Be a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident of the United States. Citizens of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia and the Republic of Palau are also eligible to apply. Must have applied for federal financial aid, for the 2024-2025 academic year, using the Free Application for the Federal Student Aid (FASFA) by mid-March 2024. Be enrolling or continuing enrollment as an undergraduate student in a U.S. accredited college or university in Fall 2024. Have a

minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 on a 4.0 scale (unweighted) or have earned a GED.

It was created with the goal of helping sponsor and support the education of talented young, minority youth.

**Fidelity Scholars Program- Deadline January 11, 2024.** 200 scholars with more than \$2.8 million in scholarships. 2.5 – 3.5 unweighted GPA or GED. Pell eligible and/or demonstrate financial need. Attend as an incoming 2024-25 freshman at a 4-year accredited college or university in the state that you reside. Student applicants must come from underrepresented populations and historically underserved communities who have faced systemic barriers and challenges to economic mobility. We specifically encourage students from Black, Latino, Native American (with documented tribal affiliation) and underrepresented Asian American/Pacific Islander heritage to apply.
