- **Golden Door Scholarship** – Open NOW and closes on **Deadline October 1, 2023** – Scholarships vary/Mainly Full Tuition to Select Schools, *Only Open to Undocumented/DACA students*, <https://www.goldendoorscholars.org/apply>
- **The Citizens Scholarship Sweepstakes (Monthly, Quarterly, and Grand Prize winners)- Deadline October 1, 2023** (“Monthly Entry Periods”) which corresponds with the start and end dates of each calendar month until the end of the Sweepstakes Period. The Sweepstakes Period is also divided into four (4) Quarterly Entry Periods (“Quarterly Entry Periods”) **ELIGIBILITY:** HS Seniors planning to enroll at least half-time within 1 year of winning award. If a student or immediate family member works for Citizens bank, then you are **NOT** eligible. Students may also qualify for DEI Quarterly scholarships. Definition of DEI students are listed on the application form. - **Brave of Heart Scholarship Program** – **Deadline October 5, 2023** – Award amounts range from \$5,000 to \$25,000 per year. Must be a child, spouse or domestic partner of a frontline healthcare worker who lost their life to a COVID-19-related cause; plan to enroll full-time or part-time in an undergraduate; plan to attend an accredited vocational-technical school, two- or four-year college or university; have a minimum grade point average of 2.0; and be a United States (U.S.) citizen or legal resident living in and attending an educational institution in the U.S. or a U.S. territory. <https://learnmore.scholarsapply.org/braveofheart/>
- **2023 Heisman High School Scholarship**- Open now and closes on **Deadline October 17, 2023** – 3.0GPA or higher, played HS sports [2023 Heisman High School Scholarship \(mykaleidoscope.com\)](https://mykaleidoscope.com/2023-Heisman-High-School-Scholarship)
- **College JumpStart Scholarship** – **Deadline October 17, 2023**- \$1000 - Submit a 250-word personal statement answering one of three questions related to educational goals and hard work. Open to 10th-12th graders, college students, and non-traditional students attending or planning to enter an accredited U.S. college or university. <https://www.jumpstart-scholarship.net/>

- **Voice of Democracy – Deadline October 31, 2023** - Range from \$1,000 to \$21,000 for national winners. - **ACFEF Scholarships for Apprenticeship, Certificate, and Post-Secondary Degree Programs – Deadline October 31, 2023** – 2.75 GPA - Be currently accepted to an accredited institution with a culinary, pastry or foodservice-related major. <https://www.acfchefs.org/ACF/Education/Scholarships/ACF/Education/Scholarships/>
 - Apprenticeship program - up to \$1,500
 - Certificate programs - up to \$1,500
 - Post-secondary degree programs - up to \$2,500
- **Financial Goals Scholarship – Deadline October 31, 2023** - \$2000. Write an essay in 500 words or less describing what steps you will take to build credit in college and how having a good credit score will help you reach your financial goals. Open to U.S. residents 18 or older who are planning to enroll or currently enrolled in a college degree program. <https://www.1fbusascholarship.com/>
- **Chick-fil-A Community Scholars – Deadline November 1, 2023** - Be recommended by a teacher, coach, community leader or mentor, addressing the applicant's personal and/or professional achievement. Up to three recommendation letters will be accepted. Show demonstrated care through community-service in the twelve (12) months prior to application. You will be asked to share in what ways you were able to make an impact on your community, friends and family. Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent). Academic awards and recognition will be considered. Applicants are required to upload a transcript that displays their name, school name, classes taken and GPA. Demonstrate financial need. Not be employed at a Chick-fil-A® restaurant or Chick-fil-A, Inc. at the time of application or the dependent or spouse of a Chick-fil-A, Inc. Employee or Operator. - **280 Group Project- Deadline November 15, 2023- How to Apply:** Write an essay of 1,000 words or less about why you would be a good candidate for the scholarship
Eligibility: Open to students pursuing a bachelor's or master's degree in business, economics, or a related field and have a GPA of at least 2.5
Amount: Three winners will receive \$500 and access to the 280 Group Certified Product Manager Online Course

Amount: Up to \$55,000 per year
